Knights of Columbus - Cor Men's Faith Formation

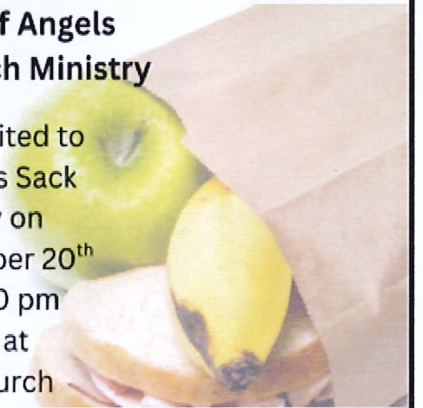

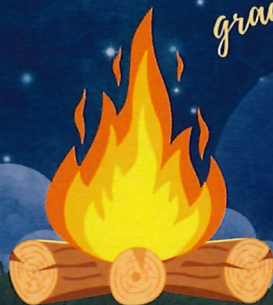

Prayer is to be offered for all through our mediator, Jesus Christ. Pierced with a sword of sorrow, Mary stood by the cross of her Son who "learned obedience from what He suffered."

By the 14th c., the sorrows of Mary numbered seven: the presentation of Jesus in the Temple; the flight into Egypt; Jesus being lost in Jerusalem; the meeting of Mary and Jesus on the way to Calvary; the crucifixion; the taking down of Jesus' body from the cross; and His burial.
