March 13th A Journey in Prayer 7:00-8:15 p.m.

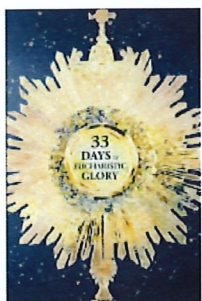
March 20th Who is God? 7:00-8:15 p.m.
