



This week, say hello to **Saint Carlo Acutis**. The first canonized millennial saint, Carlo was born in 1991 in London and raised in Milan. While his family was not particularly devout, Carlo developed a deep love for his faith at an early age. After receiving his First Communion at age seven, he began attending daily Mass and often spending time in Adoration. His example of unwavering devotion to Christ would eventually lead to the rekindling of his mother's faith, as well as many others around the world.

At school, Carlo would comfort friends and peers whose parents were undergoing divorce, as well as stepping in to defend disabled students from bullies. After school, he volunteered his time with the city's homeless and destitute, serving in soup kitchens and offering everyday acts of kindness.

A talented computer programmer, Carlo used his skills to update and develop the websites of local parishes and schools. At just eleven years old, Carlo began creating a website dedicated to cataloging every reported Eucharistic miracle around the world, which he completed by age fourteen. Carlo was also an ordinary teenager in many ways:
