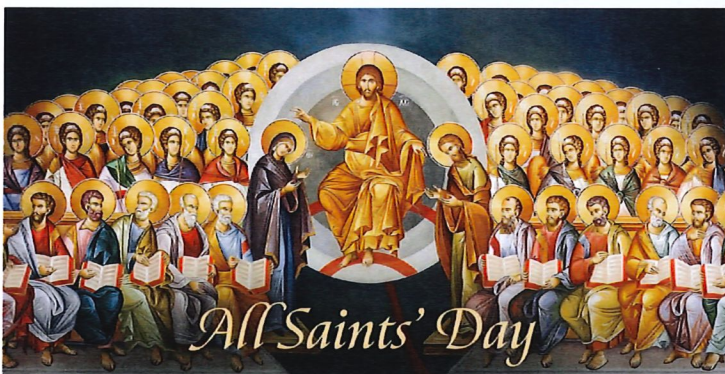

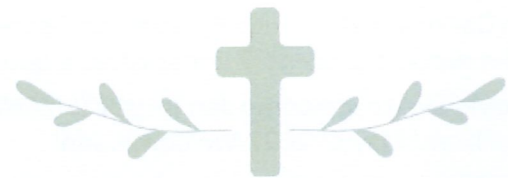
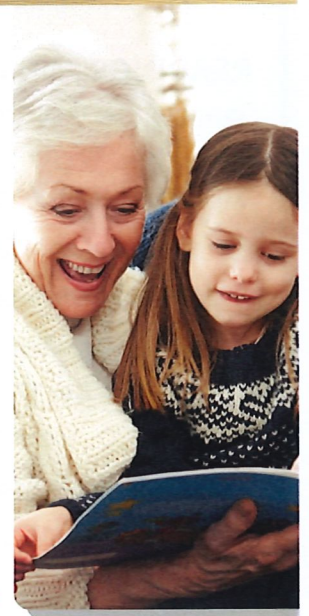

Logan County Parish Pastoral Council Summary:

Parish Council met on Tuesday evening, September 16th at 7:00pm in the St. Joseph Room at SMOW with 10 of the 12 members present (7 constitutes a quorum). Father Shawn led us in the opening prayer.

We would like to welcome Jan Knight (SMOW) to Parish Council. Jan is filling the last vacant position, and her term will end May of 2027. Welcome, Jan!

Father Shawn suggested a good Corporal / Spiritual work of service to celebrate our Jubilee year would be packing meals for distribution in Dayton. This changed to Springfield as they have a huge need due to high unemployment. Champaign County recently packed food boxes for Springfield SVDP and St. Pat's will do the same on Saturday, October 25. Please see the bulletin for more details.

Many missalettes and hymnals commonly used in Catholic parishes have been developed by companies without direct oversight from the Catholic Church. In a statement in 2020, the US Catholic Bishops expressed concern that the lyrics of hymns need better scrutiny before being used at the Mass to ensure they conform with Catholic teaching. Many parishes are shifting to missalettes that have stronger standards, such as Source and Summit. Some of the songs we currently use may not be available in Source and Summit due to those standards or due to copyrights for certain hymns that are held by other missalette companies. A motion was made by Pat Tynan and seconded by Judy Weiser to purchase the Source and Summit missalettes for St. Mary of the Woods for a one-year trial. This motion passed unanimously.

Three bids came in for the new restroom project at St. Pat's. A fourth may still come in. All three bids were higher than expected. Father Shawn wants to get input from the parishioners, and we hope to have a conceptual drawing to share in the near future.

Father gave us his blessing, and the meeting concluded at 8:30pm.

The next meeting will be November 18, 2025, in Makley Hall at St. Pat's. The meeting starts at 7:00pm and parishioners are welcome to attend.
