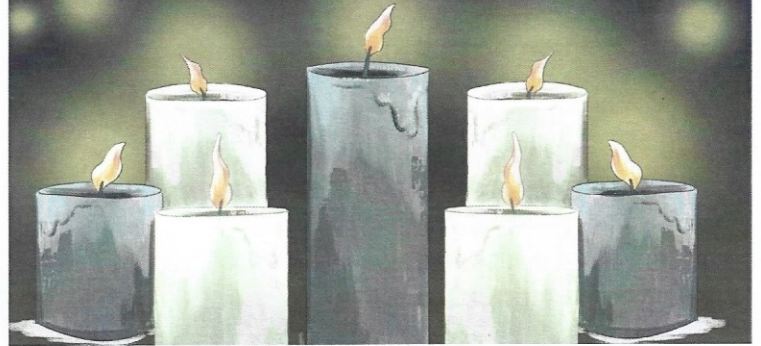

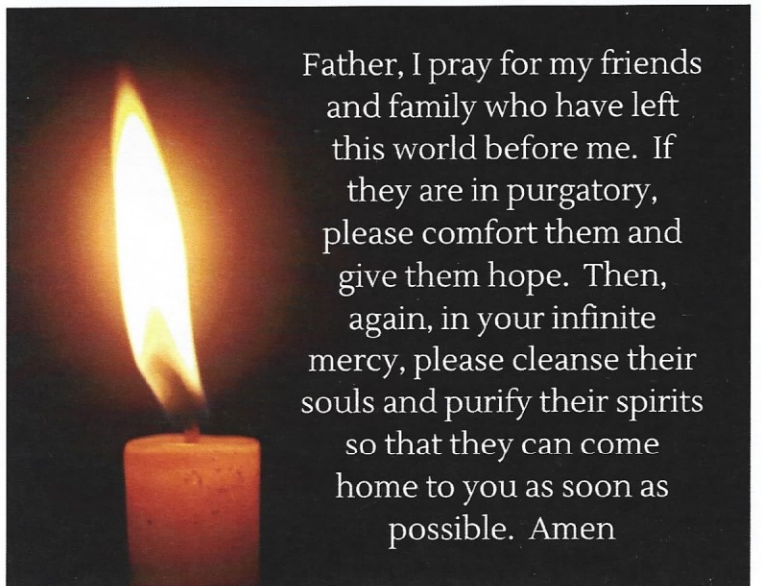

## WHO SHOULD I VOTE FOR WHEN BOTH PARTIES VIOLATE ONE OR MORE OF THE NON-NEGOTIABLES?

The Church recognizes that sometimes candidates from both parties may support an intrinsic evil. However, She does provide the means by which to know which candidate should receive our vote as we do have the duty to vote. In speaking of casting a vote for a morally difficult piece of legislation on abortion, Pope St. John Paul II wrote in *Evangelium Vitae* (73): "When it is not possible to overturn or completely abrogate a pro-abortion law, an elected official, whose absolute personal opposition to procured abortion was well known, could licitly support proposals aimed at limiting the harm done by such a law & at lessening its negative consequences at the level of general opinion and public morality. This does not in fact represent an illicit cooperation with an unjust law, but rather a legitimate and proper attempt to limit its evil aspects."
